Steel

IDPA

Looking to add some excitement to your shooting experience? Do you want to become more proficient with your firearm? Why not come down Sunday, May 14th and join us for our monthly IDPA style match. We shoot on the second Sunday of the month at 10 AM. There is a brief, required safety meeting at 9:45 sharp.

We held the first match of the year on April 12. The 21 participants were treated to 5 exciting stages and 1 warm-up stage. IDPA stages are "real life" scenarios where you get the chance to take out some bad guys, test your wits, and shooting skills while being timed. All you need is a 9mm or larger handgun, a couple of mags, a holster and about 120-150 rounds of ammo.

We will set up a couple of stages, brief you on how to play, give you some tips and time you. Bring as much ammo as you like. Once you try it you'll love it! Come on down!
